Small crochet hook

B=border stitches. You can choose to knit these or be creative.

- BIND OFF

Eye: Cut two 4-inch pieces of brown yarn. Holding pieces together, tie a knot in the middle. Place eye using crochet hook to pull yarn ends to the back. Tie off and cut yarn. Repeat for second eye.

Nose: Cut four 4-inch pieces of red yarn. Holding all four together tie knot in middle. Place nose and pull ends through. Tie off and cut yarn.

Tip: When tying off yarn, tie only two ends together at a time so it's not as bulky in the back.
